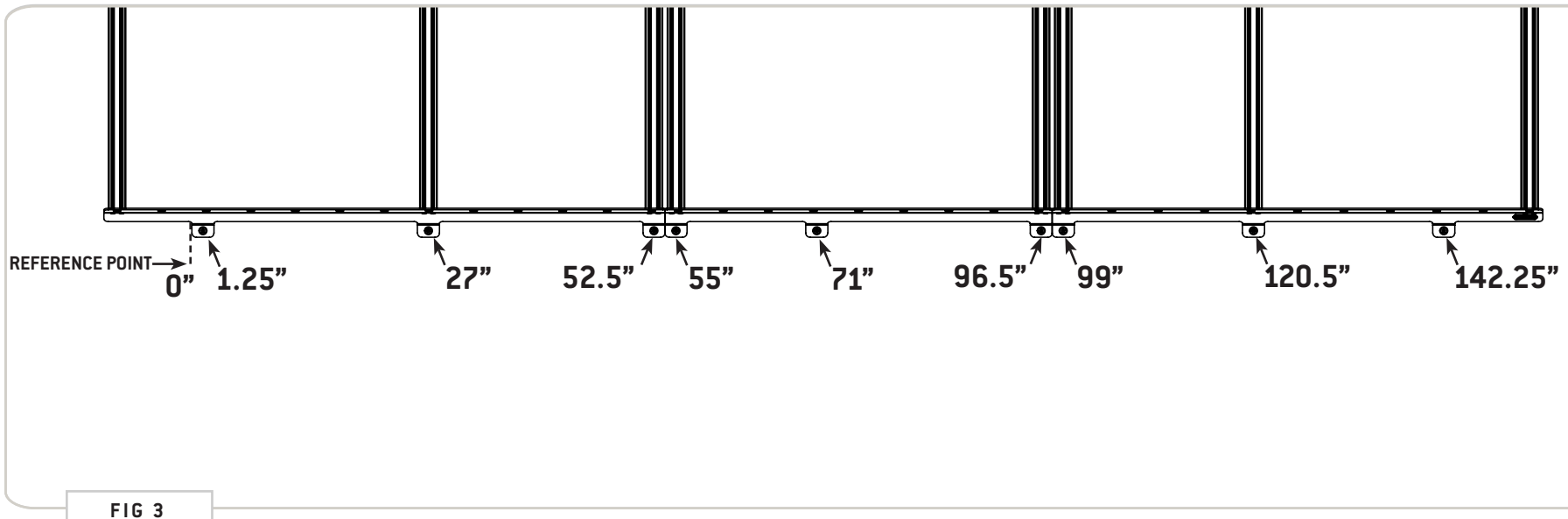
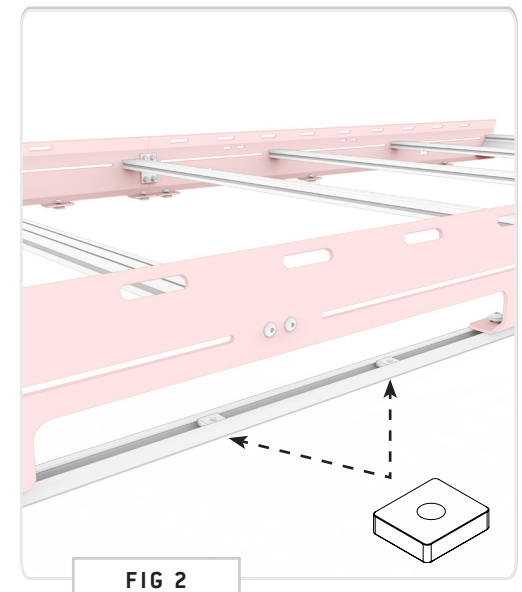
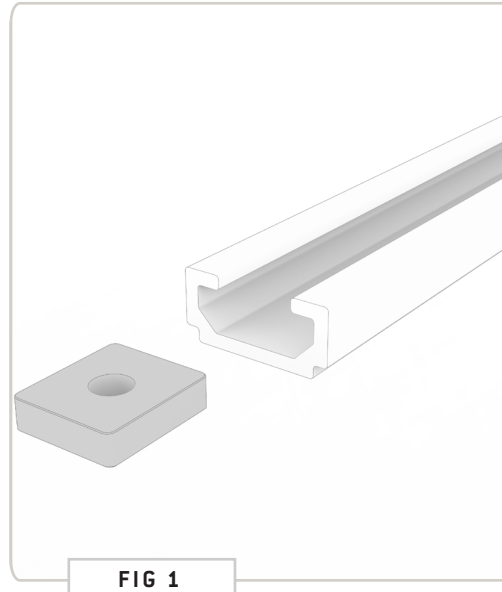
TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + MEASURING TAPE

STEP | 01 LAYOUT AND INSTALL PREP

1.1 Install Rail Nuts: Slide half of the **Rail Nuts** into the passenger side factory roof rail, and the half of them into the driver side rail (**FIG 1**).

PRO-TIP: If you're installing a side ladder, put two (2) extra rail nuts in on the driver side (**FIG 2**).

1.2 Layout Rail Nuts: Space out the **Rail Nuts** close to their final positions as roughly laid out in **FIG 3**.



TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 7/32" ALLEN WRENCH

STEP | 02 SIDE RAIL INSTALL

2.1 Install Side Rails: Beginning with the forward section of the rack (see FIG 5 for layout), start loosely attaching the side rails to the roof rails using the **3/8-16" Button Head Screws & 3/8" Lock Washers**, but do not tighten them all the way down (FIG 4).

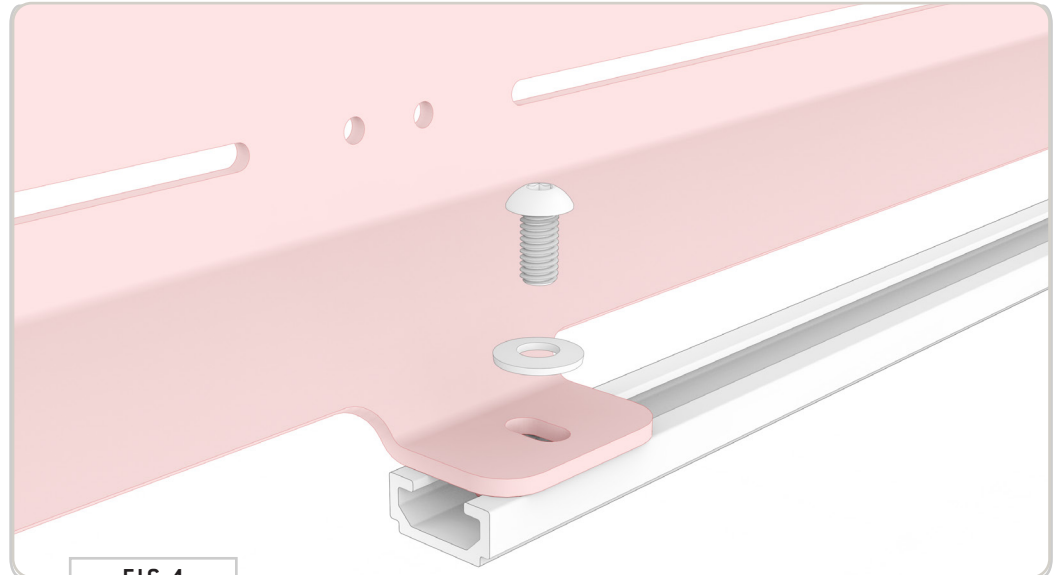

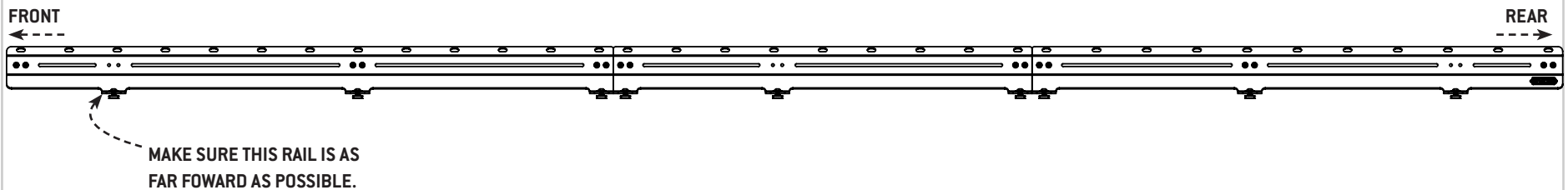

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 3/16" ALLEN WRENCH

STEP | 03 CROSSBAR INSTALL

3.1 Layout Crossbar Locations: Position the crossbars in your desired locations, loosely threading in the **1/4-20" Flange Head Screws** to hold in place (**FIG 6**).

NOTE - If purchased with a front fairing, save a crossbar for Fairing Assembly in the next step. Proceed to Step 5 if purchased without.

NOTE - Keep in mind the layout of your roof top array (solar panels, fans, tents, etc.) You can mount crossbars in the set pair of holes (**FIG 7**), or you can place them in the slots which provides you more freedom of layout.

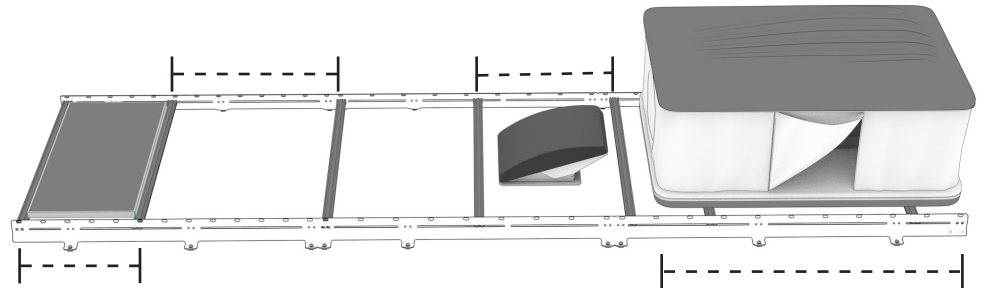

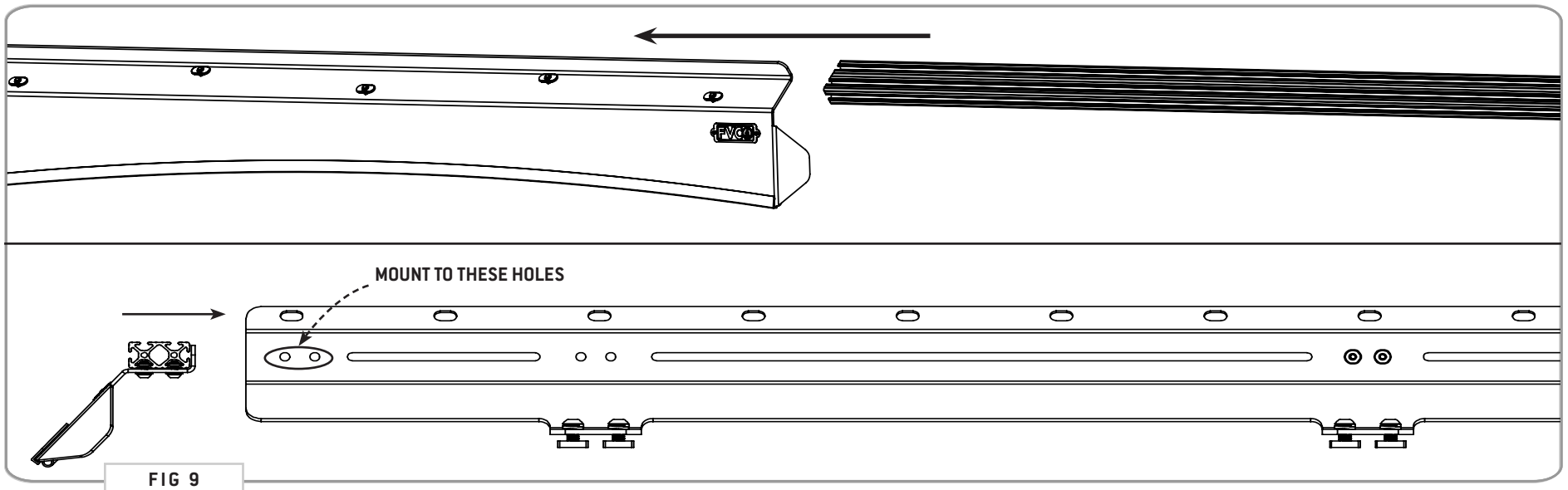
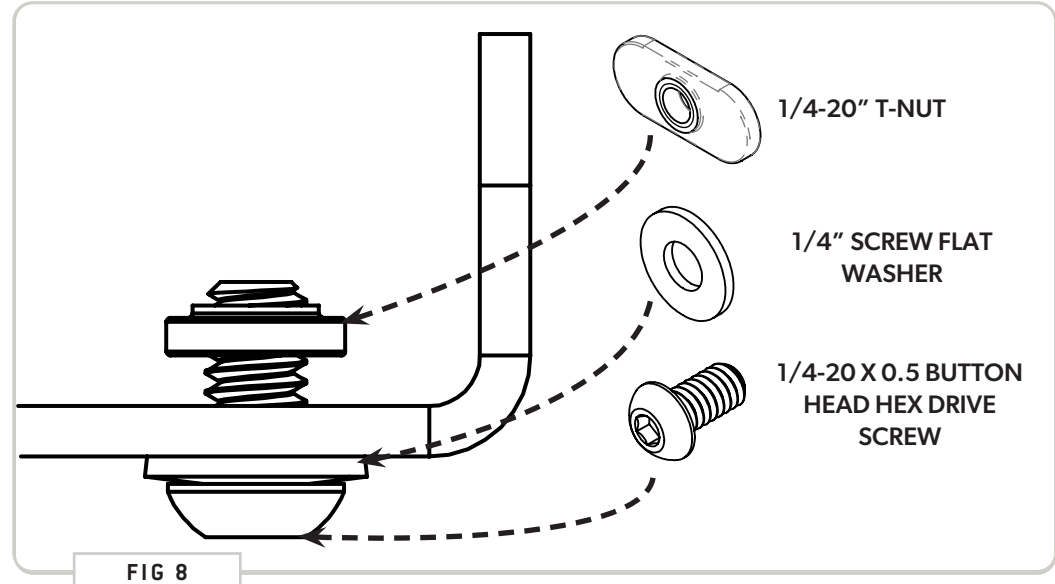
TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 5/32" ALLEN WRENCH
+ 3/16" ALLEN WRENCH

STEP | 04 FAIRING INSTALL

4.1 Fairing Assembly: Insert the hardware as shown in **FIG 8** into the available slots in the fairing. You'll only want to screw the t-nuts on a little in order to provide clearance for the next step.

4.2 Crossbar Install: Now, slide the crossbar onto the fairing. You'll have to straighten each t-nut as you go to get it to feed into the crossbar correctly (**FIG 9**). After sliding the fairing and crossbar together, tighten all five (5) of the 1/4-20" Button Head Screws.

4.3 Fairing Install: Now you're ready to attach the fairing to the roof rack. Slide it in from the front and into the location shown in **FIG 9** and tighten down using (2) 1/4-20" Flange Head Screws.



STEP | 05 FINAL ADJUSTMENTS

5.1 Tighten Crossbar Fasteners: Tighten all crossbar bolts using the 3/16" Allen Wrench.

NOTE - *Do not overtighten! If you are concerned about the bolts backing out, you can put a dab of blue loctite on the bolts before tightening down completely.*

5.2 Tighten Rail-to-Rail Fasteners: Now tighten Side Rails to Roof Rail using the 7/32" allen key.

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 3/16" ALLEN WRENCH
+ 7/16" WRENCH OR SOCKET

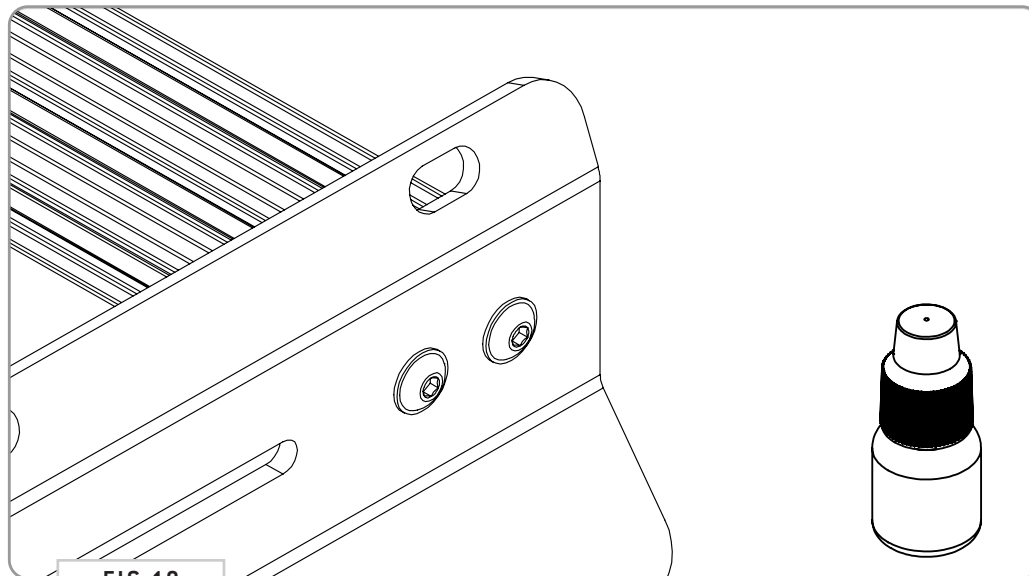

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + MEASURING TAPE

STEP | 01 LAYOUT AND INSTALL PREP

1.1 Install Rail Nuts: Slide (10) ten of the Rail Nuts into the passenger side factory roof rail, and (6) six into the driver side rail (FIG 1).

PRO-TIP: If you're installing a side ladder, put two (2) extra rail nuts in on the driver side (FIG 2).

1.2 Layout Rail Nuts (Driver's Side): Space out the Rail Nuts close to their final positions as roughly laid out in FIG 3.

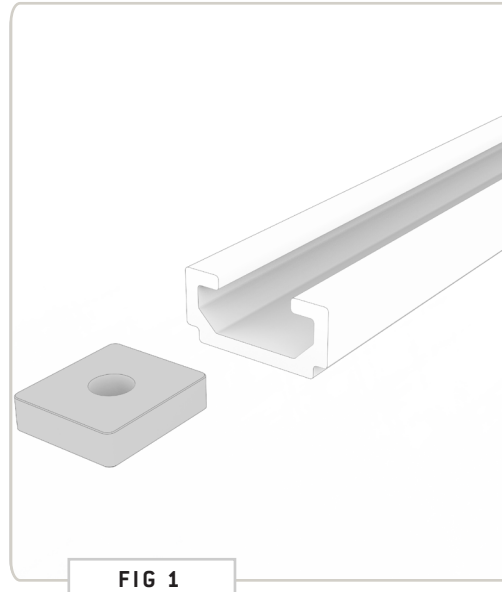

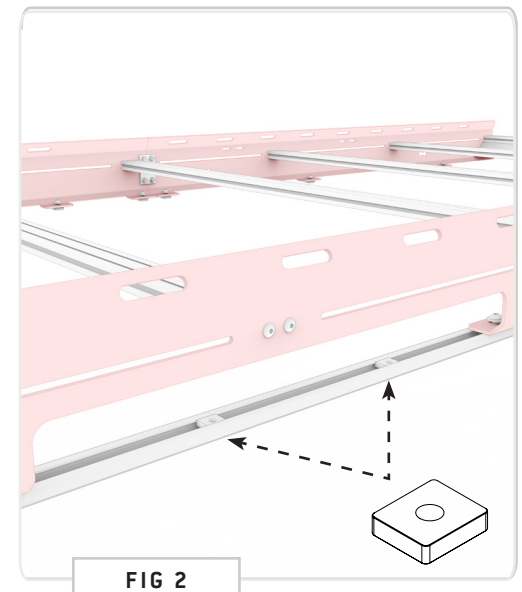

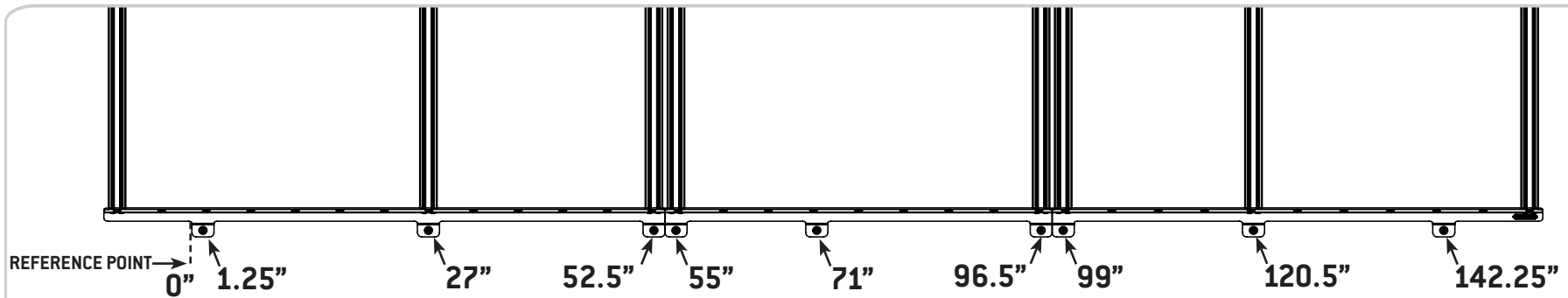

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 7/32" ALLEN WRENCH

STEP | 02 SIDE RAIL INSTALL

2.1 Install Side Rails: Beginning with the forward section of the rack (see FIG 5 for layout), start loosely attaching the side rails to the roof rails using the **3/8-16" Button Head Screws & 3/8" Lock Washers**, but do not tighten them all the way down (FIG 4).

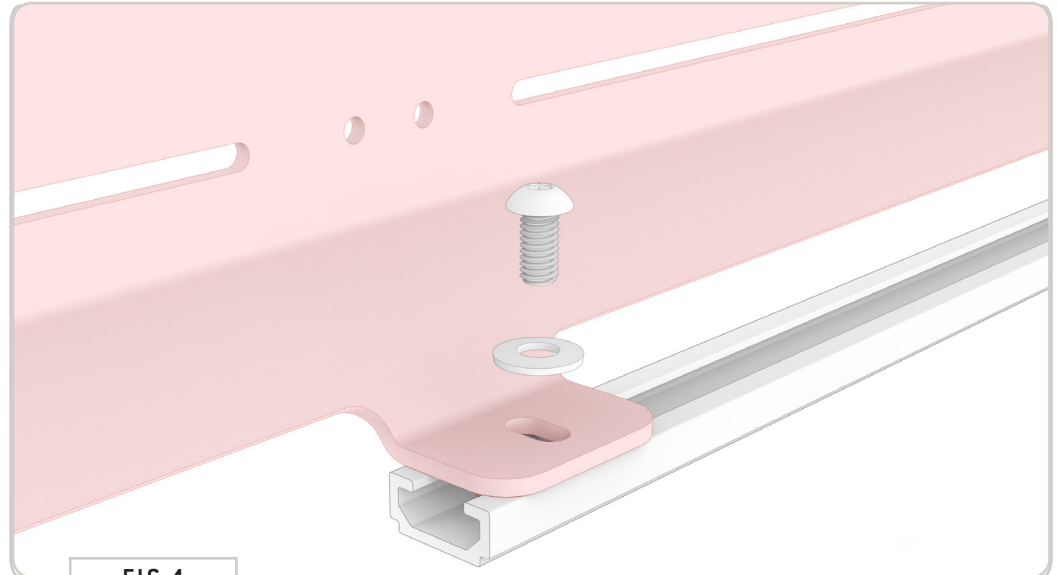

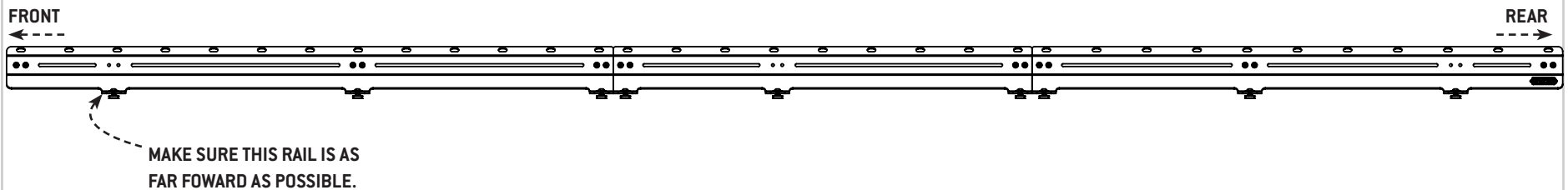

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 7/32" ALLEN WRENCH

STEP | 02 SIDE RAIL INSTALL

2.2 Install Front and Rear F80 Brackets: Next, find your **Front And Rear F80 Brackets** and Align them with the corresponding rails of the **Driver's Side** (FIG 6).

2.3 Install Center F80 Brackets: Grab your Center Brackets and space them out in between the front and rear brackets. FIG 6 and 7 depict an example layout of F80 brackets with the low pro roof rack. Loosely attach to the roof rails using the **3/8-16" Button Head Screws & 3/8" Lock Washers**.

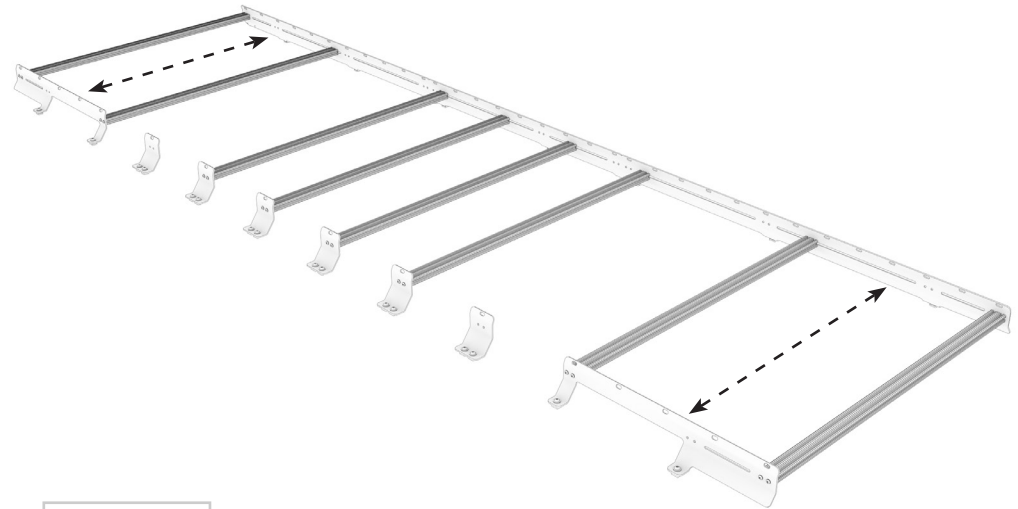

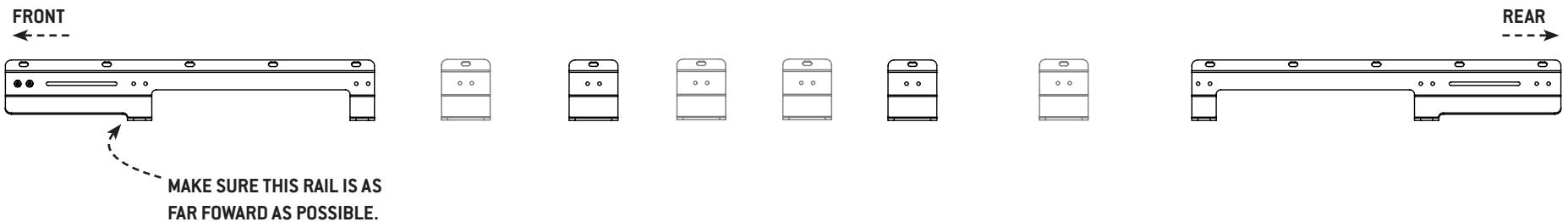

STEP | 03 CROSSBAR INSTALL

3.1 Layout Crossbar Locations: Position the crossbars in your desired locations, loosely threading in the **1/4-20" Flange Head Screws** to hold in place (**FIG 7**).

NOTE - If purchased with a front fairing, save a crossbar for Fairing Assembly in the next step. Proceed to Step 5 if purchased without.

NOTE - Keep in mind the layout of your roof top array (solar panels, fans, tents, etc.) You can mount crossbars in the set pair of holes (**FIG 8**), or you can place them in the slots which provides you more freedom of layout.

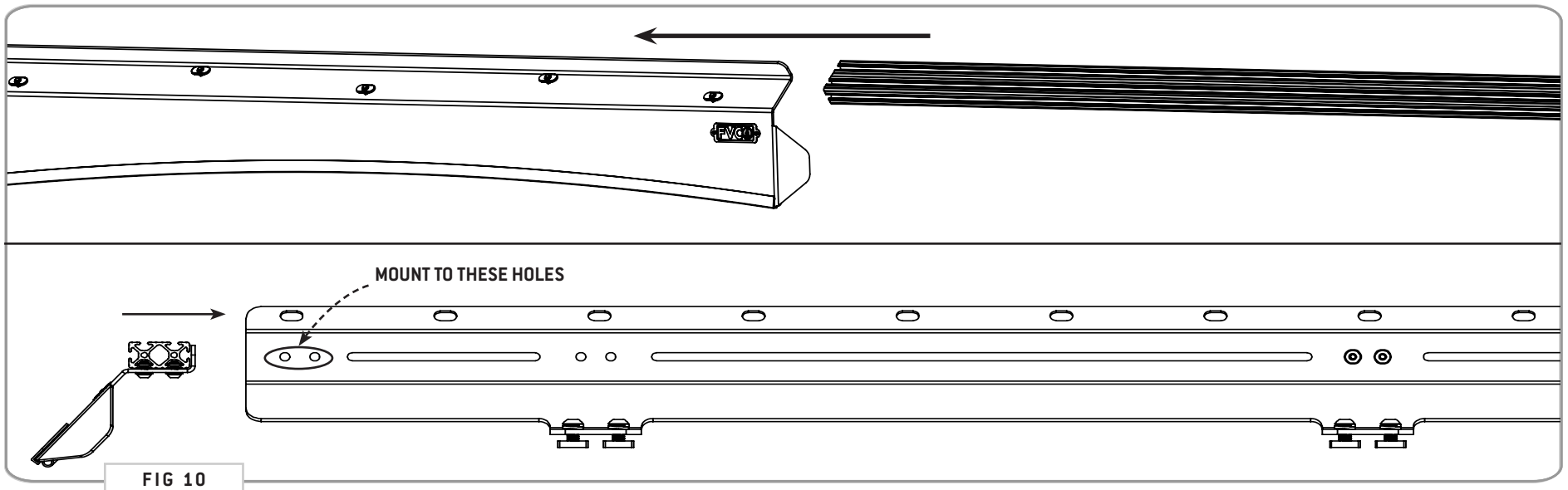
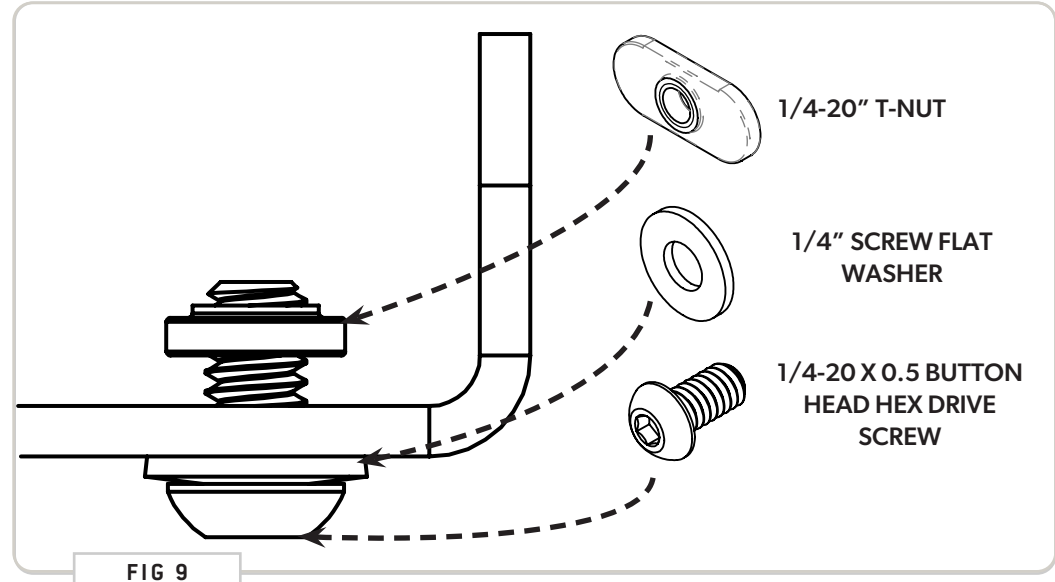
TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 5/32" ALLEN WRENCH

STEP | 04 FAIRING INSTALL

4.1 Fairing Assembly: Insert the hardware as shown in **FIG 9** into the available slots in the fairing. You'll only want to screw the t-nuts on a little in order to provide clearance for the next step.

4.2 Crossbar Install: Now, slide the crossbar onto the fairing. You'll have to straighten each t-nut as you go to get it to feed into the crossbar correctly (**FIG 10**). After sliding the fairing and crossbar together, tighten all five (5) of the 1/4-20" Button Head Screws.

4.3 Fairing Install: Now you're ready to attach the fairing to the roof rack. Slide it in from the front and into the location shown in **FIG 9** and tighten down using (2) 1/4-20" Flange Head Screws.



STEP | 05 FINAL ADJUSTMENTS

5.1 Tighten Crossbar Fasteners: Tighten all crossbar bolts using the 3/16" Allen Wrench.

NOTE - *Do not overtighten! If you are concerned about the bolts backing out, you can put a dab of blue loctite on the bolts before tightening down completely.*

5.2 Tighten Rail-to-Rail Fasteners: Now tighten Side Rails to Roof Rail using the 7/32" allen key.

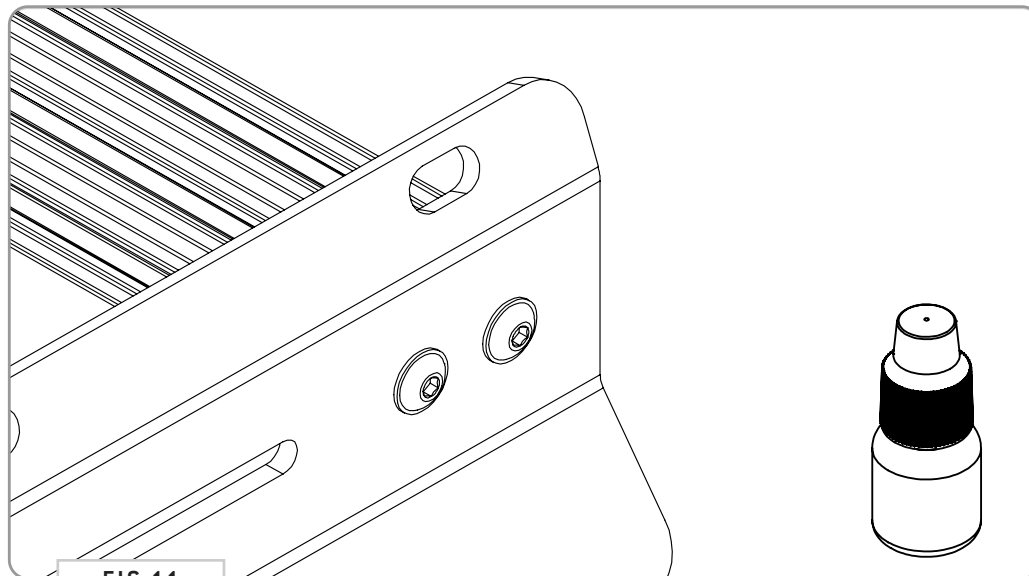

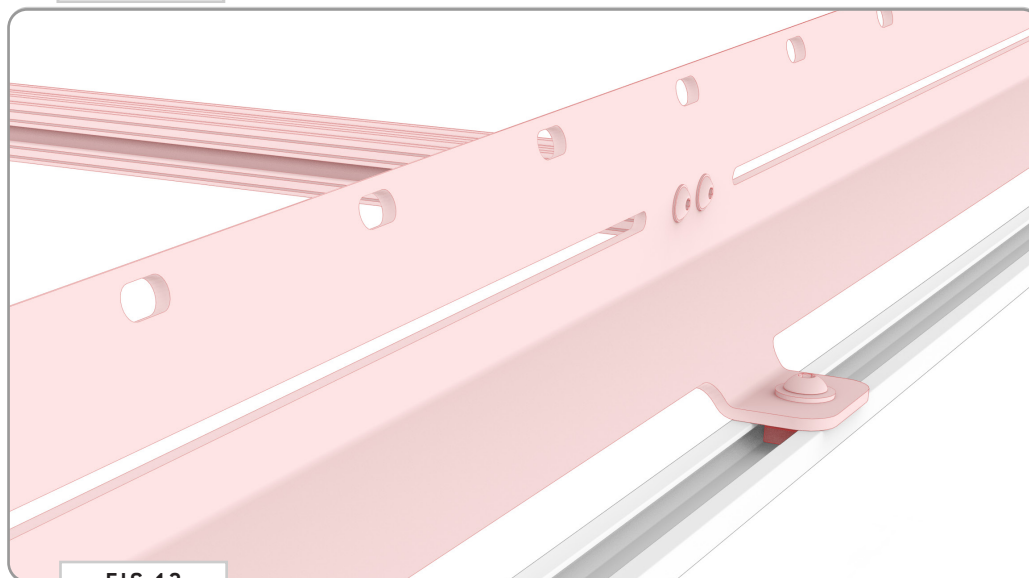
