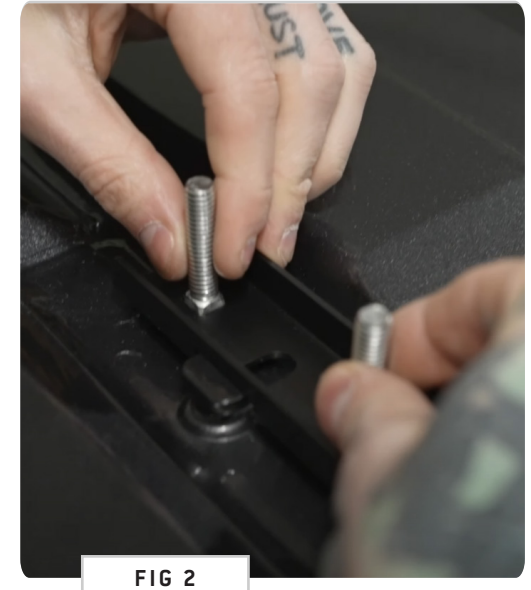
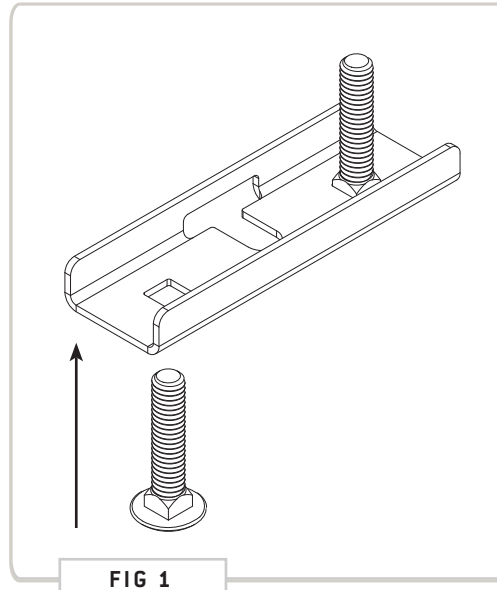
STEP | 01 LANDING PAD INSTALL

1.1 Install Anchor Stud Brackets: Insert two **5/16-18 Carriage Bolts** through an **Anchor Stud Bracket** (**FIG 1**) and slide the assembly into place along one of the **Anchor Studs** along the rooftop of the van (**FIG 2**).

NOTE - Slide the **Anchor Stud Bracket** under the **Anchor Stud** on the roof. For best results, slide it from the inside towards the outside of the van.

1.2 Position Clamp Brackets: Once all of the **Anchor Stud Brackets** have been placed, slide the **Clamp Bracket** down over the top of them as shown in **FIG 3**.

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP:



STEP | 02 SIDE RAIL INSTALL

2.1 Install Side Rails: Place the **Side Rails** onto the protruding **5/16" Carriage Bolts** and loosely secure them with **5/16" Washers and Nylock Locknuts** (FIG 4+5).

2.2 Secure Rails With Connecting Plates: Utilize **Rail Connecting Plates** to connect the front and rear rails together using **1/4"-20 Flanged Head Screws, Flat Washers and Nylock Locknuts** (FIG 6+7).

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP:

- + 7/16" WRENCH OR SOCKET
- + 5/32" ALLEN WRENCH
- + 3/16" ALLEN WRENCH

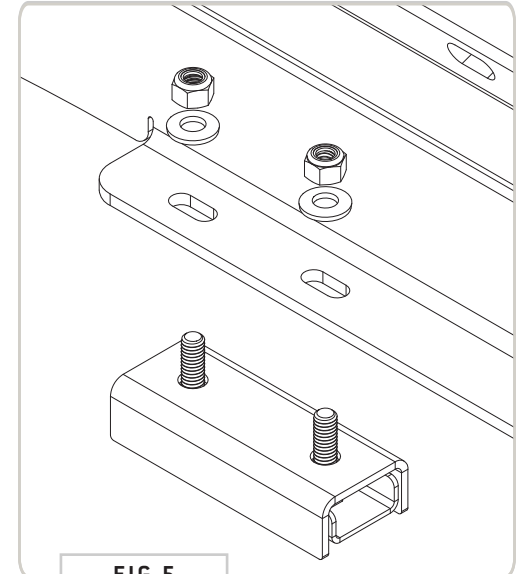

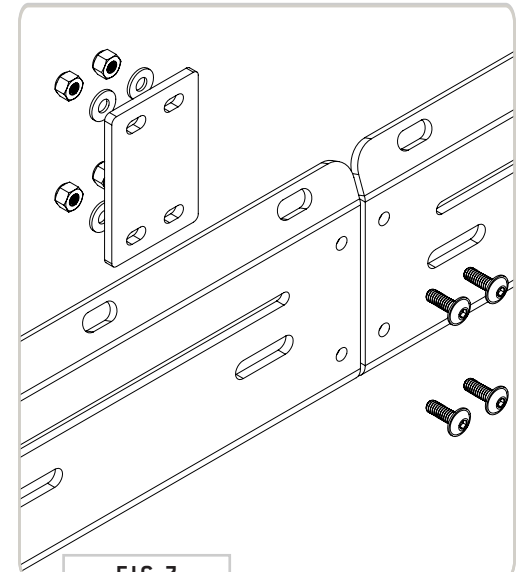

STEP | 03 CROSSBAR INSTALL

3.1 Layout Crossbar Locations: Position the crossbars in your desired locations, loosely threading in the **1/4-20 Flange Head Screws** to hold in place (**FIG 8+9**).

NOTE - Leave one crossbar aside for mounting the fairing in the next step.

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 3/16" ALLEN WRENCH
+ 5/32" ALLEN WRENCH

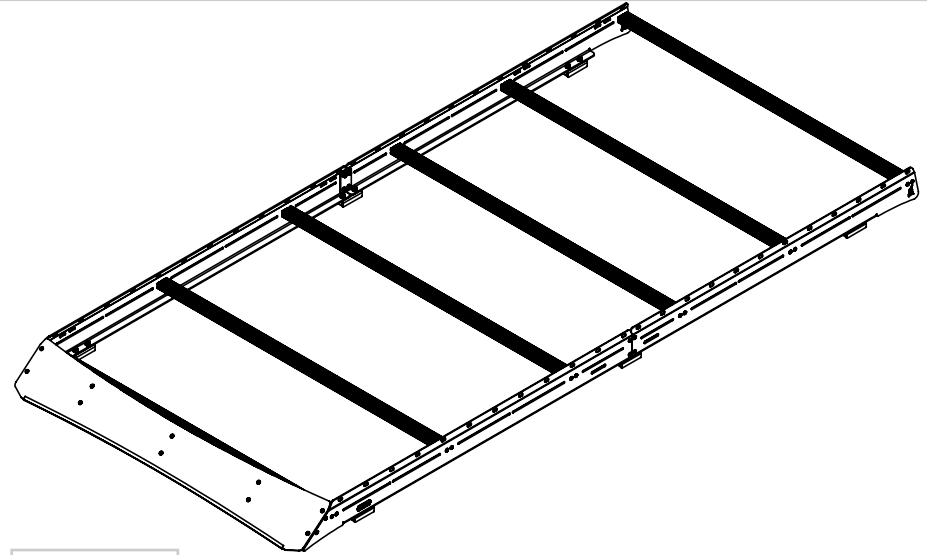

STEP | 04 FAIRING ASSEMBLY

4.1 Fairing Assembly: Loosely assemble the **Fairing Brackets** with (2ea) 1/4-20" Button Head Screws, Lock Washers and T-Nuts as shown in **FIG 10**. Slide the assemblies into the crossbar (**FIG 11**) along the locations shown in **FIG 12**.

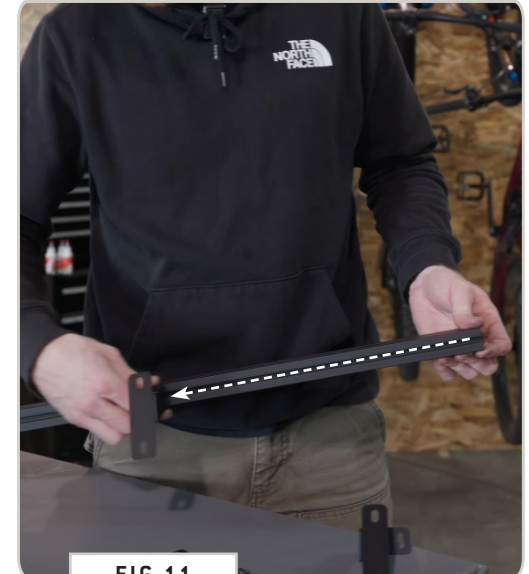

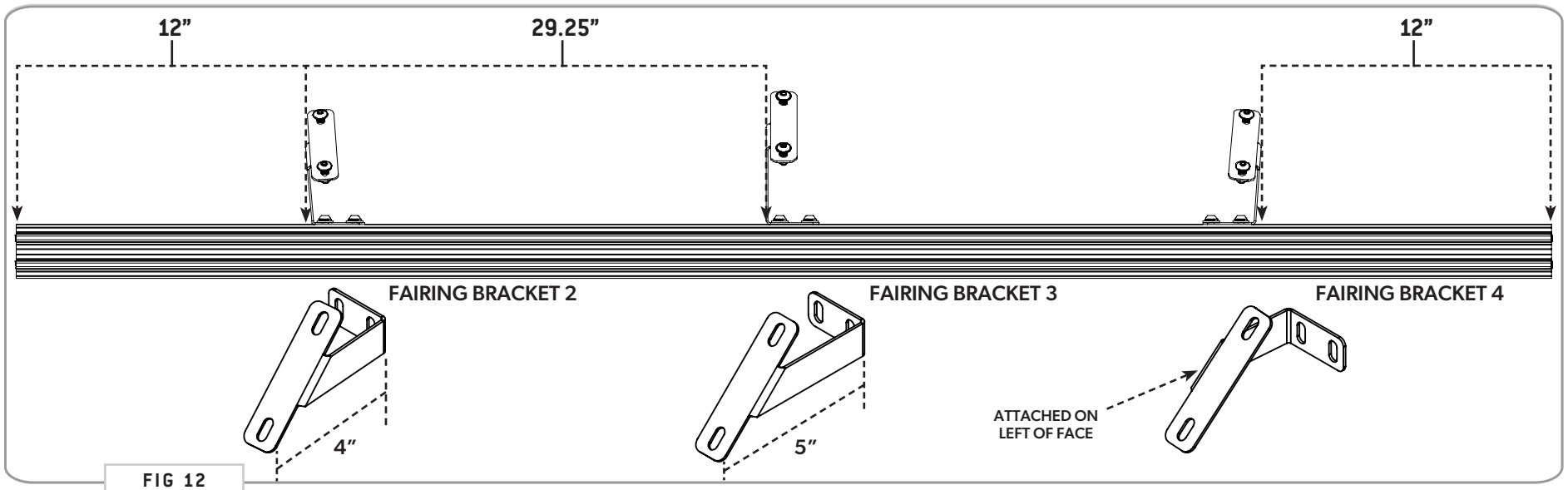

STEP | 04 FAIRING ASSEMBLY

4.2 Secure Fairing Brackets to Crossbar: Align holes in face of **Fairing** to those of the **Fairing Brackets** to confirm correct fitment and secure to **Crossbar** by tightening down the 1/4"-20" **Button Head Screws** (FIG 13).

4.3 Attach Fairing: Loosely attach the **Fairing** to the **Fairing Brackets** using 1/4"-20 **Flanged Head Screws**, **Flat Washers** and **Nylock Locknuts** (FIG 14).

4.4 Attach Fairing Brackets 1 and 5: Loosely attach **Fairing Brackets 1 and 5** to the **Fairing Assembly** using 1/4"-20 **Flanged Head Screws**, **Flat Washers** and **Nylock Locknuts**. Note that the flanged face of these Fairing Brackets will face outward as shown in FIG 15.

4.5 Attach Trim Gasket: Complete the assembly by attaching the **Trim Gasket** (FIG 16). Make sure that the "bulbed" side of the trim is facing the Crossbar, as that will be the part that sits against the van.

PRO-TIP: Gently tap the **Trim Gasket** using a mallet to seat it down tight against the **Fairing**.

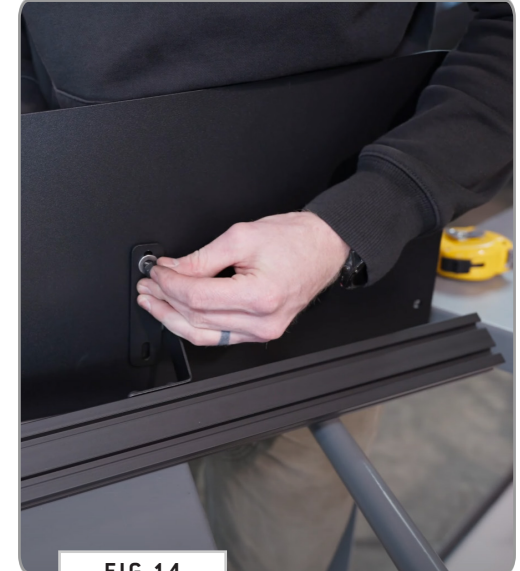

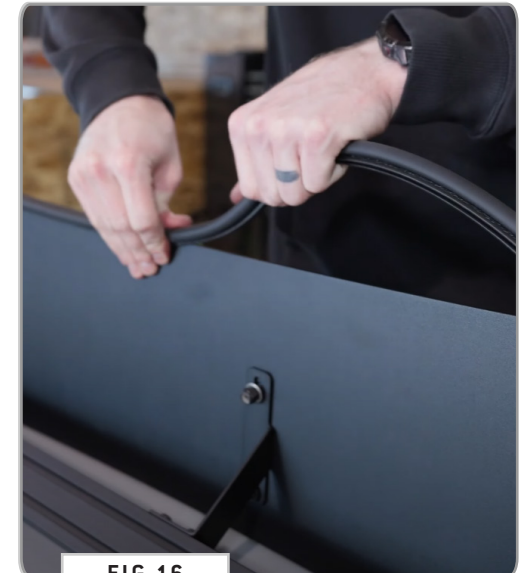

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 5/32" ALLEN WRENCH
+ 3/16" ALLEN WRENCH
+ 7/16" WRENCH OR SOCKET

STEP | 05 FAIRING INSTALL

5.1 Install Fairing: With help, lift the **Fairing Assembly** up to the front of your **Roof Rack** and gently lay it down on a soft surface (**FIG 17**).

5.2 Tighten Fairing to Brackets: There is a bit of adjustment built in to the **Fairing Brackets** so that you maintain a tight seal against the van body during install. Proceed to tighten down the fasteners holding the **Fairing** to the **Fairing Brackets** once you've determined an appropriate fit (**FIG 18**).

5.3 Tighten Fairing to Side Rails: Tighten down the fasteners holding the **Fairing Assembly** to the **Side Rails** (**FIG 19**).

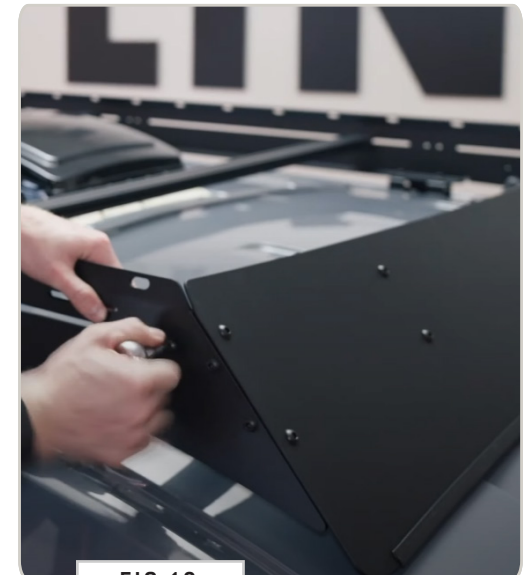

STEP | 06 ADJUSTMENTS AND TUNING

6.1 Secure Crossbars: Begin tightening the **Crossbars** into place, starting with the front-most crossbar.

6.2 Front-To-Back Adjustment: Check to make sure you are happy with your alignment to the van Front-To-Back. Once you are happy with how the rack is aligned, proceed to tighten down fasteners holding the **Side Rails** to the **Landing Pads** (**FIG 20**).

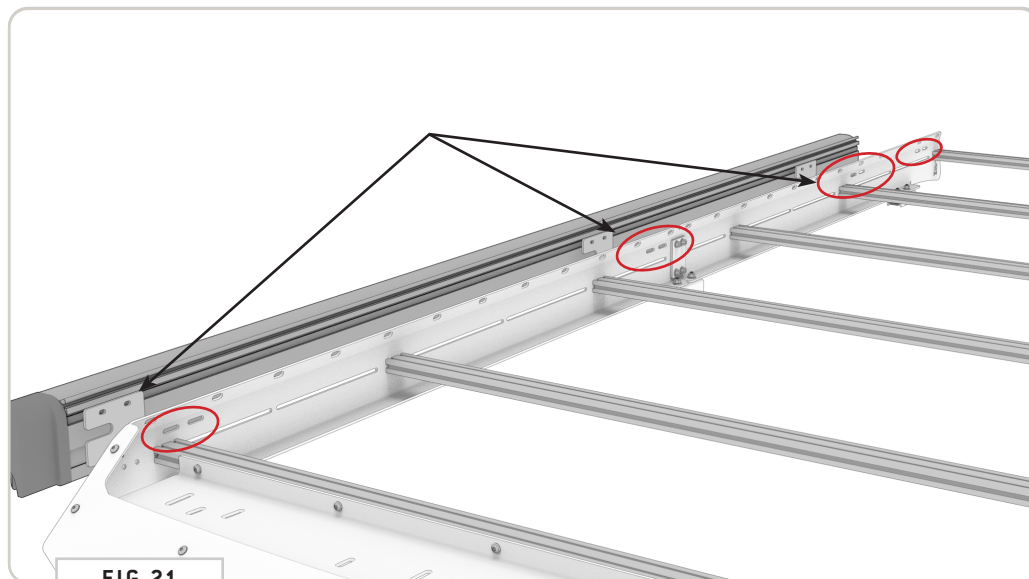


FIG 21

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

6.3 Fiamma Awning Install (Optional): If installing a **Fiamma F45s Or Similar Awning**; we have conveniently placed **Mounting Holes** as shown in **FIG 21** for you to bolt your support brackets to.

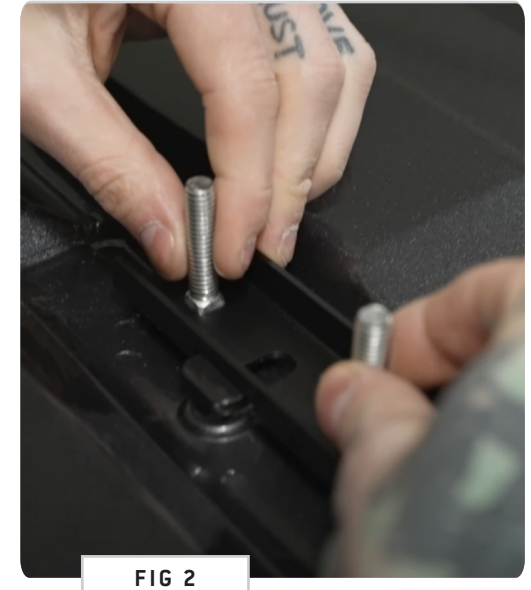
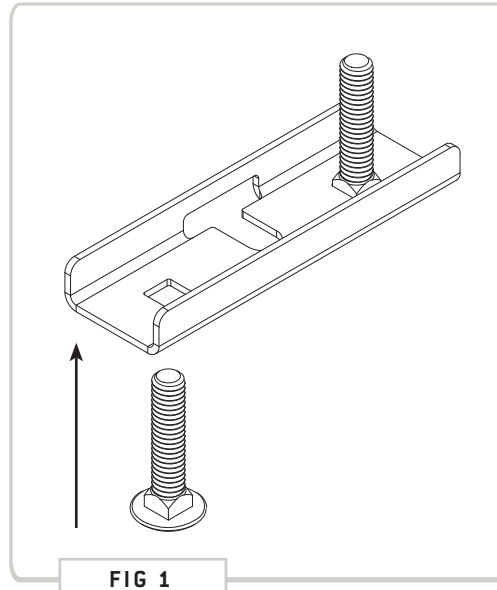
STEP | 01 LANDING PAD INSTALL

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NOTE - Slide the **Anchor Stud Bracket** under the **Anchor Stud** on the roof. For best results, slide it from the inside towards the outside of the van.

1.2 Position Clamp Brackets: Once all of the **Anchor Stud Brackets** have been placed, slide the **Clamp Bracket** down over the top of them as shown in **FIG 3**.

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP:



STEP | 02 SIDE RAIL INSTALL

2.1 Install Side Rails: Place the **Side Rails** onto the protruding **5/16" Carriage Bolts** and loosely secure them with **5/16" Washers and Nylock Locknuts** (FIG 4+5).

2.2 Secure Rails With Connecting Plates: Utilize **Rail Connecting Plates** to connect the front and rear rails together using **1/4"-20 Flanged Head Screws, Flat Washers and Nylock Locknuts** (FIG 6+7).

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP:

- + 7/16" WRENCH OR SOCKET
- + 5/32" ALLEN WRENCH
- + 3/16" ALLEN WRENCH

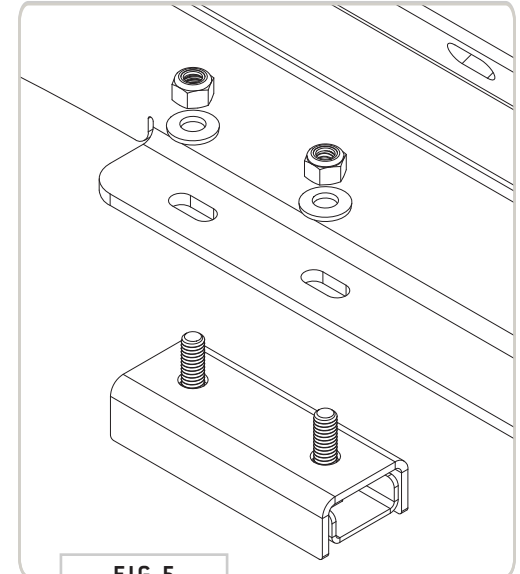

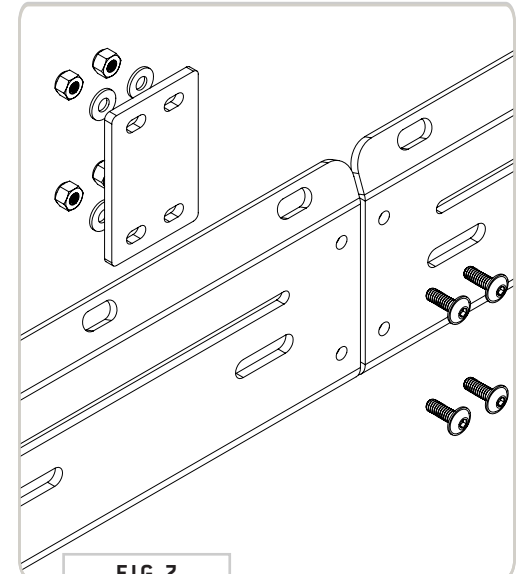

STEP | 03 CROSSBAR INSTALL

3.1 Layout Crossbar Locations: Position the crossbars in your desired locations, loosely threading in the **1/4-20 Flange Head Screws** to hold in place (**FIG 8+9**).

NOTE - Leave one crossbar aside for mounting the fairing in the next step.

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 3/16" ALLEN WRENCH
+ 5/32" ALLEN WRENCH

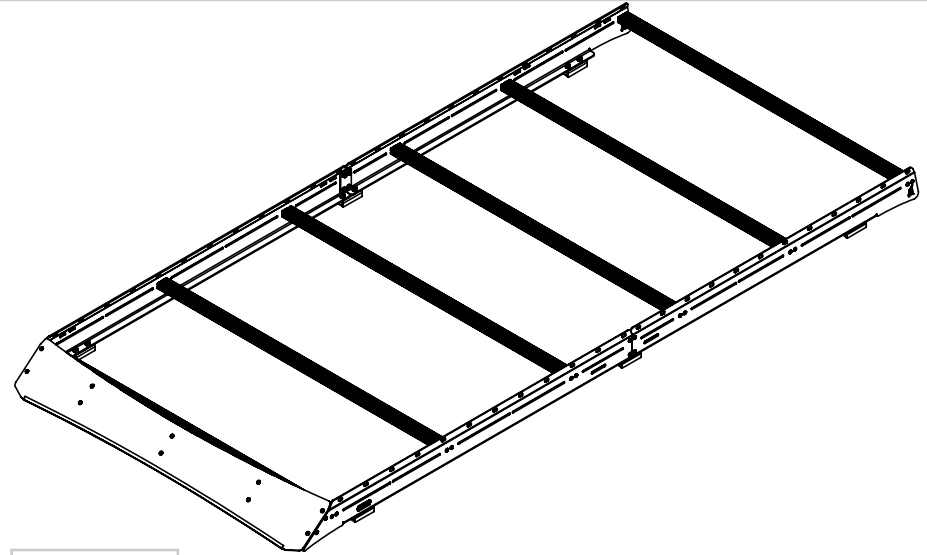

TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 5/32" ALLEN WRENCH

STEP | 04 FAIRING ASSEMBLY

4.1 Crossbar Fairing Bracket: Stack a 1/4-20" x 0.5 Button Head Screw and 1/4" Belleville Lock Washer as shown in FIG 10 and insert into the six available front holes of the **Fairing Light Bar Tray**. Loosely assemble using a **T-Nut**. You'll only want to screw the **T-Nuts** on a little in order to provide clearance for the next step.

4.2 Crossbar Install: Now, slide the **Crossbar** onto the **Crossbar Fairing Bracket**. You'll have to straighten each **T-Nut** as you go to get it to feed into the crossbar correctly (FIG 11 + 12).

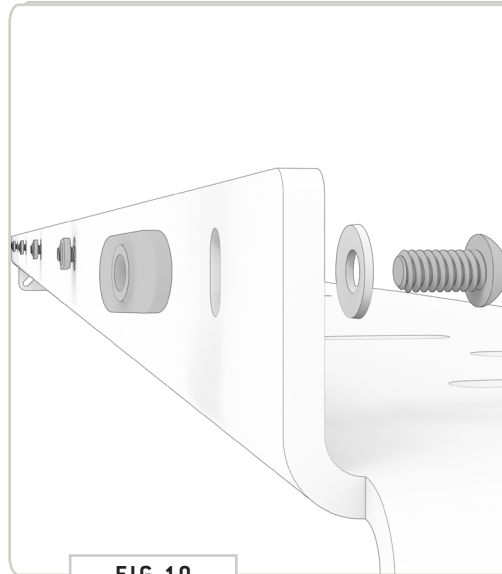

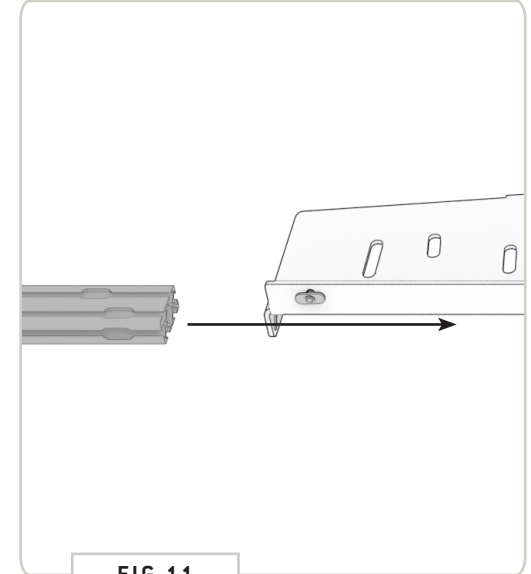

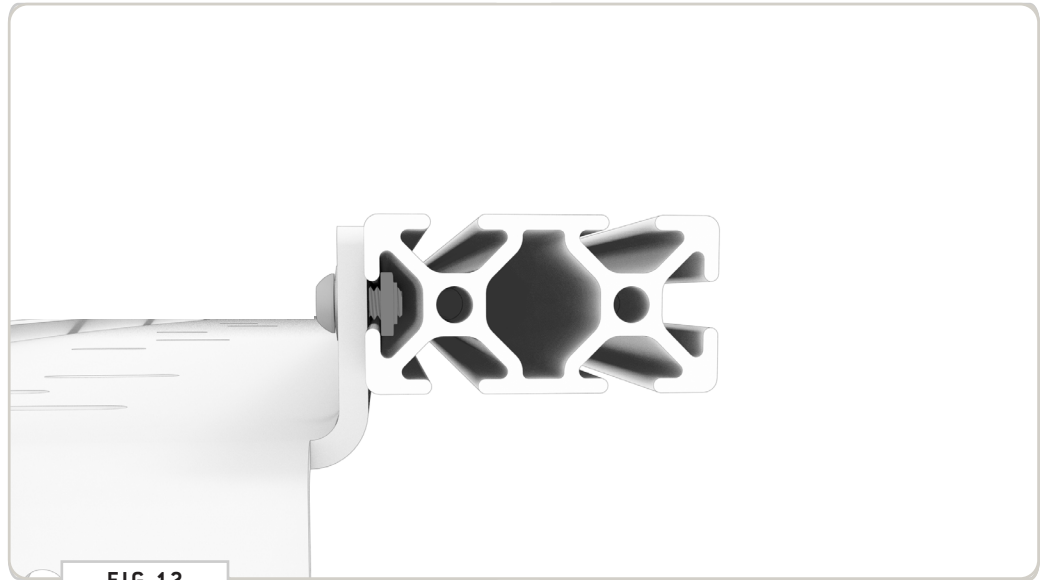

STEP | 04 FAIRING ASSEMBLY

4.3 Attach Front Fairing: Attach the **Front Fairing** to the Assembly using **1/4-20 x 0.75 Flanged Button Head Screws, Flat Washers and Nylon Locknuts (FIG 13 + 14).**

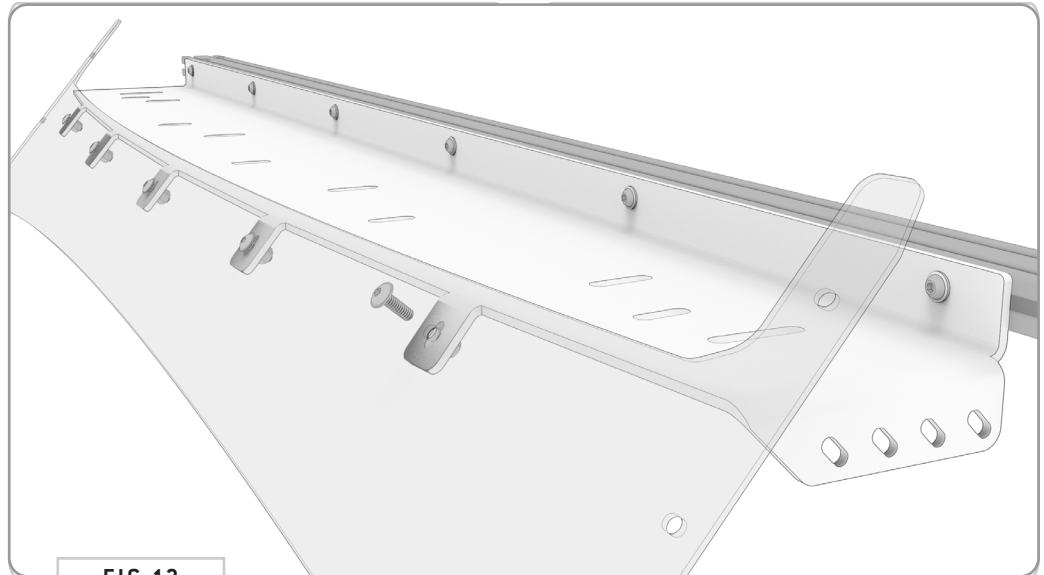

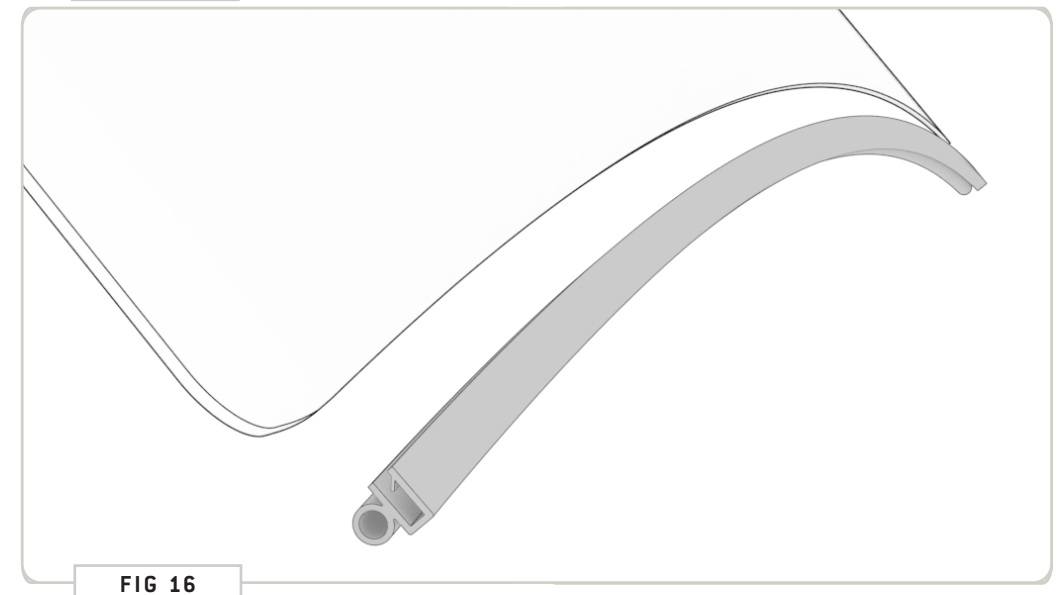
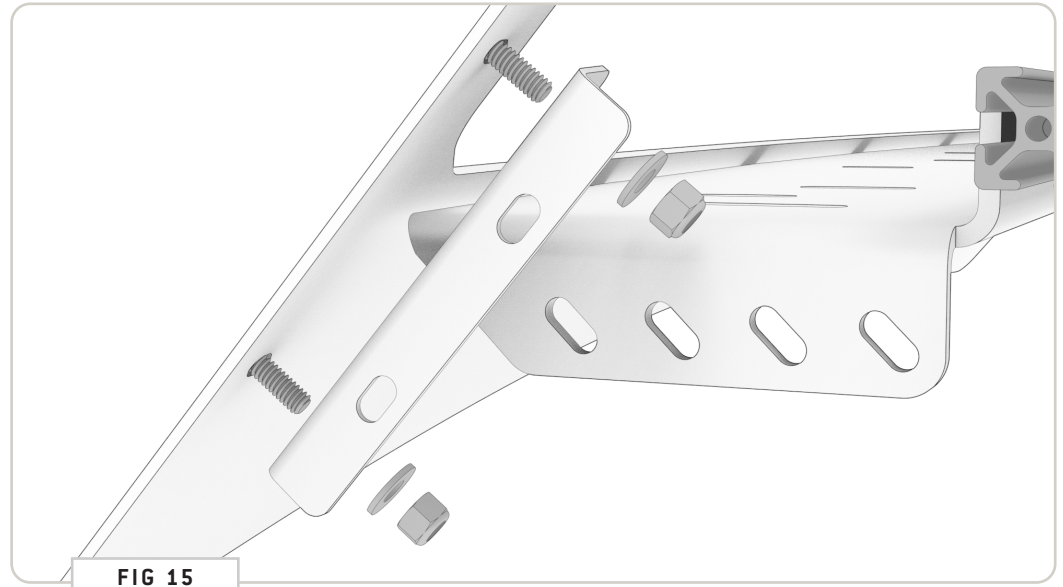
TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THIS STEP: + 5/32" ALLEN WRENCH

STEP | 04 FAIRING ASSEMBLY

4.4 Attach Fairing Side Brackets: Loosely attach **Fairing Side Brackets** to the **Fairing Assembly** using **1/4"-20 Flanged Head Screws, Flat Washers and Nylock Locknuts**. Note that the flanged face of these Fairing Brackets will face outward as shown in **FIG 15**.

4.5 Attach Trim Gasket: Complete the assembly by attaching the **Trim Gasket** (**FIG 16**). Make sure that the "bulbed" side of the trim is facing the Crossbar, as that will be the part that sits against the van.

PRO-TIP: Gently tap the **Trim Gasket** using a mallet to seat it down tight against the **Fairing**.

STEP | 05 FAIRING INSTALL

5.3 Tighten Fairing to Side Rails: Tighten down the fasteners holding the **Fairing Assembly** to the **Side Rails** (**FIG 19**).

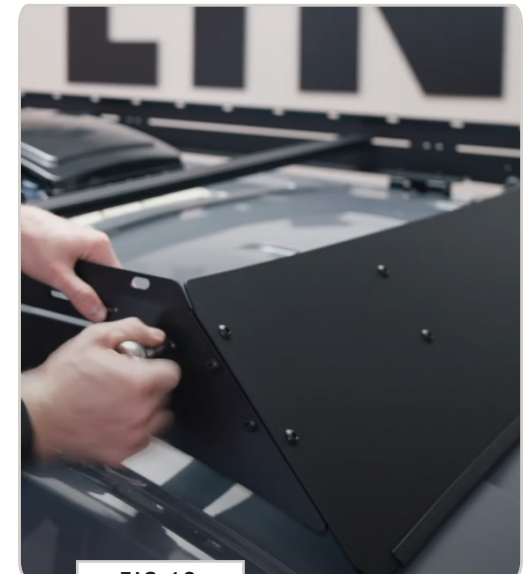

STEP | 06 ADJUSTMENTS AND TUNING

6.1 Secure Crossbars: Begin tightening the **Crossbars** into place, starting with the front-most crossbar.

6.2 Front-To-Back Adjustment: Check to make sure you are happy with your alignment to the van Front-To-Back. Once you are happy with how the rack is aligned, proceed to tighten down fasteners holding the **Side Rails** to the **Landing Pads** (FIG 20).

6.3 Fiamma Awning Install (Optional): If installing a **Fiamma F45s or Similar Awning**; we have conveniently placed Mounting Holes as shown in FIG 26 for you to bolt your support brackets to. This will require the use of the included Awning Spacers.

6.4 Attach Spacer Brackets to Awning Mounting Brackets: Insert **One (1)** of the **Awning Mount Spacer Brackets** onto each **Awning Mounting Bracket**.

6.5 Attach Awning to Roof Rack: Attach the **Awning** to your **Low Pro Roof Rack** and fasten back down.

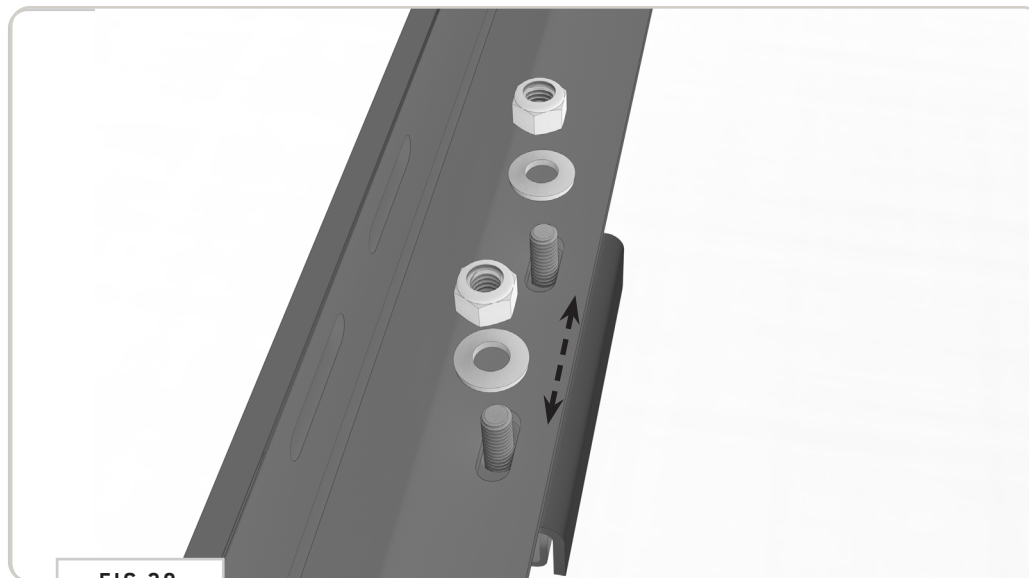
